The Mama Cleos Boys home, started in 2019, with only 3 children, the main idea was to support children in situations of abandonment or abuse, the need to help this type of children has been increasing year after year, currently We have 16 children from the ages of 3 months to 17 years, once they reach the age of majority, they can choose to continue with us in the transition house, where we support them and prepare them for life abroad.

Our vision is to rescue children and adolescents from an uncertain future, due to the bad experiences they had in their past, our mission is to help them overcome their traumas, accepting them as they are, showing the love of God through our lives.

Our goal is to empower our children, giving them the necessary tools so that when they are adults they can make good decisions in their lives and contribute positively to their community.

Where can I start, many things have happened at Mama Cleo's Boys Home, 2023 was a year of many challenges a lot of ups and downs, but also many victories, What I can highlight is that God has been so good to us, even though we do not deserve it, he only wanted & wants to bless us, our family, and our ministry.

In January 1st 2023, all our boys together, the little ones and the older ones as well, we had a great conversation about what we wanted God to help us accomplish for 2023, they had their wishes and desires written in a piece of paper, and we talked about it, the majority mentioned that they wanted a bigger home, at this time we all were at the San Antonio House, where we all were too tight because of how many we were in that small house, so, I told them, we all have to be praying for this request until God grants us with it, so every night since January we started to pray for our new home, day after day, week after week, until April of that year, when God responded our prayer request, God touched the heart of great people who bought a bigger house for us, we were so blessed and our boys experienced the power of prayer.

We moved in our new home in April the 1st, we were happy about it, but after 15 days we started to face some issues, lack of water, not enough energy, normally at 5pm we got out of power (electricity) no fridges, no power at all, the boys changed many habits, like going to bed early, no TV so they started to play as normal kids, run around the house, play hide & sick, play all kinds of games that don't require an electronic device, it was good seeing the kids playing normal games like we used to do it when we were children. They did not realize about the problems we started to face in this new property, they were so happy because they had a bigger home.

As time went by, we started to get our food damage because of no fridges working during the night, we needed to fix this problem, so we began to pray about it, then, God new this was so much for me, that he started to bring great people to help us do fundraisers to get money for projects to improve our home.

Thanks to those fundraiser, money came and we begin to make many improvements, like:

- New solar lithium batteries for our home
- More showers added to our boys' bathrooms
- Provisional Roof on top of our kitchen and patio
- Civil Protection Training to our staff
- Civil protection equipment as well as sighs (extinguishers, etc)
- Civil Protections supervision from Government

NEW PROPERTY

God blessed us with a bigger property, where our boys can play, run and do many other things in a safety enviroment.

LITHIUM BATTERIES

The new house did not have a contract with CFE, so we had to work through solar bateries that we bought from Texas, US. These batteries are better quality Now the power (electricity) last longer and we have fridges working properly all day and night.



BIGGER INVERTER

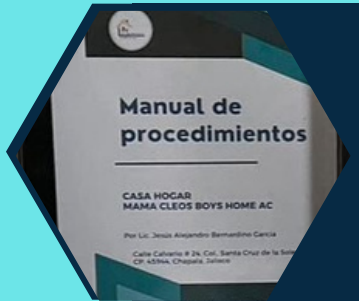
We had to renew all our electrical adaptations, we were blesed with new inverter, solar panels and lithium bateries.

The home had a outside kitchen uncovered, we had to put metal roof to protect us from rain.



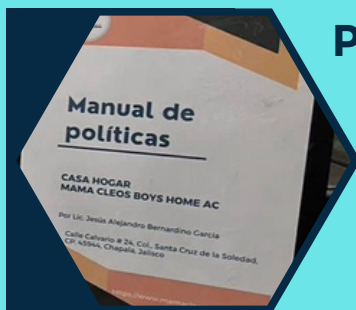
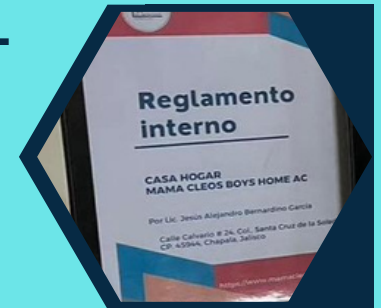


PROCEDURES MANUAL

We also needed to have a Internal Rules for the staff and children, we worked hard to accomplish all of these but it's done.

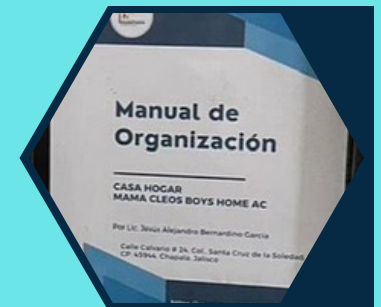


POLICIES MANUAL

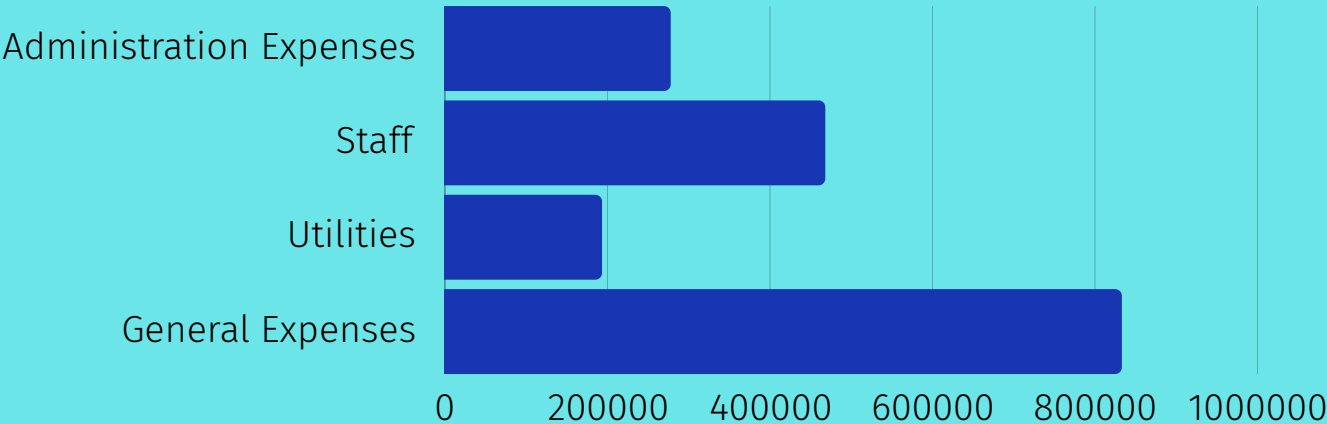


TOTAL REVENUE
